FULL BIO:

Glitch Cake is a trip hop / electro pop duo based in Brooklyn, NY. The band is comprised of Kat Tingum (vocals, electronics) and Poyraz Aldemir (drums). The duo draws on dance beats, layered vocals and glitch art.

Glitch Cake has a love of glitch art and vintage technology. The band incorporates vintage pieces and sounds into their music, videos and live performances, including old portable television sets, corded phones and vintage radio players. The band creates mind bending interactive projection art which they perform alongside during live shows. They utilize projection mapping to create eerie performance art, including a live performance at the Glitch Music Hackathon at Spotify Headquarters NYC, where visual artist Claire Kwong projected a video of Kat's face onto herself as she sang, while the video feed glitched in real time to the music.

In New York, Glitch Cake has performed at Harvestworks Digital Media Arts Center, Nublu, Drom, The Bowery Electric, and more. Poyraz, the drummer, grew up and studied jazz drumming in Izmir, Turkey, and was recently a featured artist in Jazz Magazine Turkey. Glitch Cake's music has been used in several film scores, including the horror film *12 Midnight* and the short film thriller *Taking It Too Far*. Glitch Cake's newest single "Transfer" is available on all major streaming platforms, and is accompanied to an 80's inspired cyberpunk thriller music video now available on YouTube.
